Sumgayit State University (SSU) carries out responsibilities, which comes from "No Poverty" Sustainable Development Goal (SDG 1) by making higher education accessible to a diverse student population. Here is included state scholarships for students, Bright Future Scholarship Program for international talented students, financial assistance for low-income students, and support for socially vulnerable groups.





Support Initiatives at Sumgayit State University

- •State Scholarships: 2123 students out of 6405 benefit from state scholarships.
- •Privileged Students: The university provides targeted support for 950 students from families of martyrs, veterans, the disabled, and those who have lost both parents. These students receive additional assistance to ensure they have equal opportunities.
- •Student Trade Union Committee Initiatives covers the food expenses of at least 250 students annually, helping to alleviate food insecurity among the student body.
- •Financial Aid for Low-Income Students: 100 low-income students receive financial assistance every year.
- •Incentives for High-Performing Students: In addition to financial aid, 50 active students with high GPAs are rewarded with money and other incentives.

The University provides scholarships to students from low-income families and with high performance, both at its own expense and through its partner institutions.
